Kids Hurt Too Co-Parenting Education Seminar

Held in Grayson County 2 times each month

The Kids Hurt Too Co-Parenting Education Seminar started in 1997 in Grayson County due to the District Judges' heartfelt concern for the well being of children of divorce. Since that time, thousands of parents have attended the seminar. The seminars are facilitated by licensed mental health professionals.

The standing order reads, in part: "the parties are ordered to successfully complete said seminar within sixty (60) days of either (a) the filing of the petition or motion to modify or (b) the receipt of notice of the petition or motion, and prior to any final hearing."

It is our privilege to work with the district court judges and attorneys in Texoma to help divorcing parents understand the impact divorce has on their children and how they can avoid placing their children in the middle.
